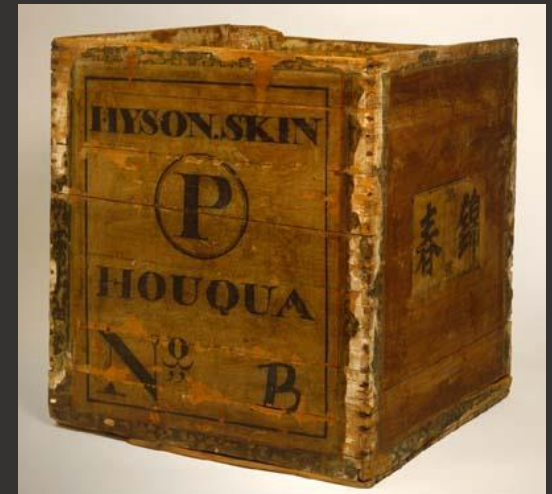
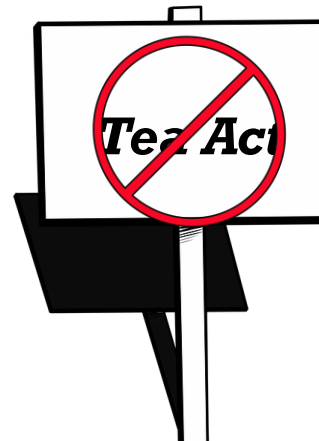
1770- BOSTON MASSACRE

- *The Boston Massacre was a deadly street riot that took place on king street; it was a fight that broke out between a group of American Colonists and a single British soldier it ended in a bloody slaughter and a sudden hate against the British and their beliefs. This was the kickoff to the revolution.*

1773-BOSTON TEA PARTY

On December 16th, 1773 116 men got onto docked British ships and dumped a fortune in tea into the ocean.

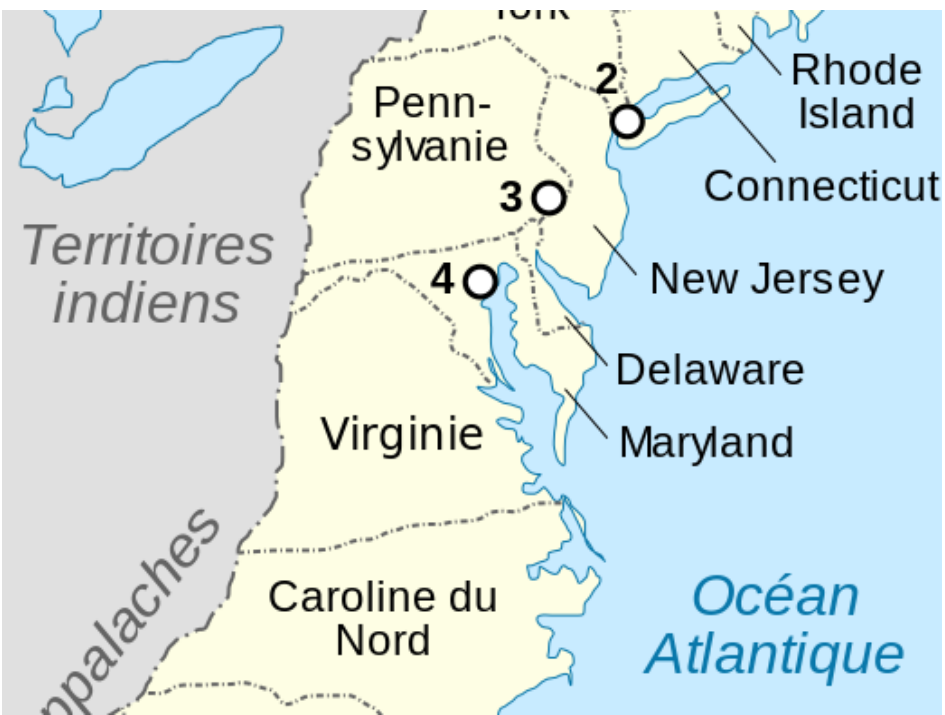
The Boston Tea Party was a protest against the tea act that protected the British East Indian Company.





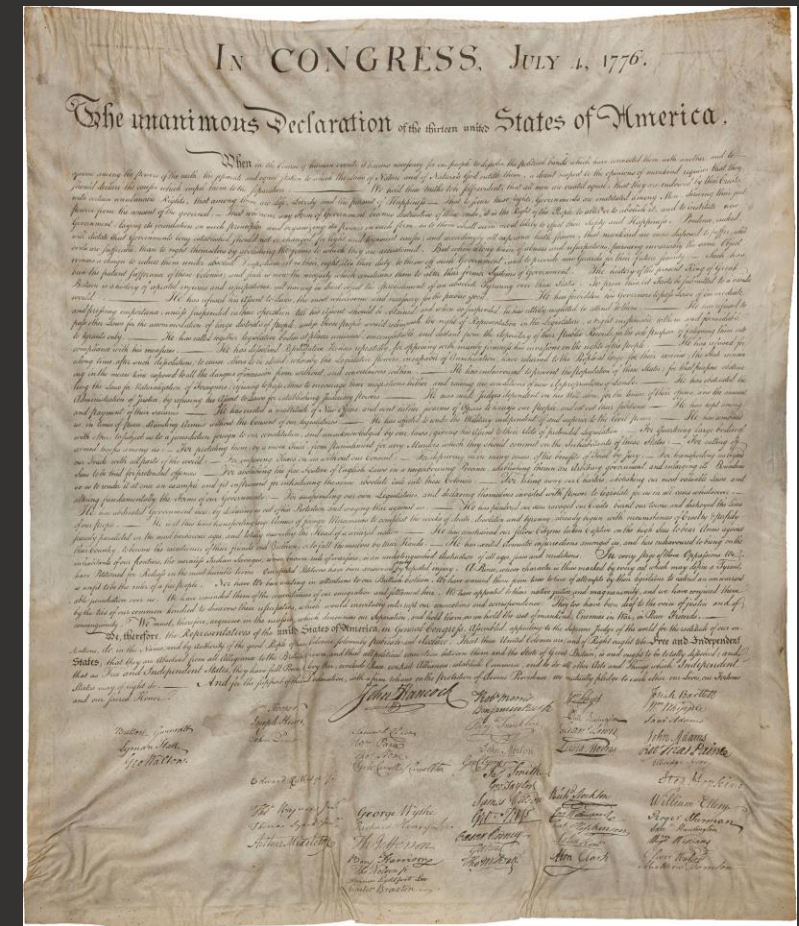
1775- BATTLE OF LEXINGTON

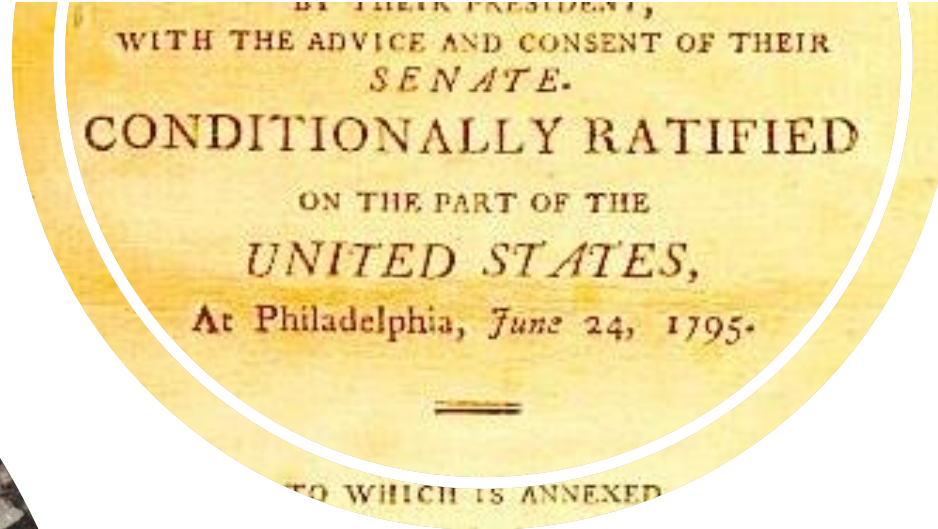
- *Rebel forces invaded Canada they where they were possessing Montreal meanwhile, they were attacking Quebec city.*

1776-THE DECLARATION OF INDEPENDENCE

- The declaration of independence was written by mostly by Thomas Jefferson in 1776, it was written to show Americas independence from Brittan and to show that every person has rights and we are all considered equal, and as we all know that didn't stop all discrimination of course but it did make a difference.





TREATY OF PARIS

- The Treaty of Paris is a treaty that was made wrap up the revolution up the 7-year war between the French and Indian signed by representatives of Brittan and Hanover on one side and France and Spain on the other.
- It was signed in Paris on February 10th, 1763.

1765-STAMP ACT PASSED

- In 1765 the stamp act was passed by the British this was a tax put in place to make up the money they lost in the war tax effected American printing companies the most because every piece of paper published had to have a stamp on it witch of course cost money.





1775-BUNKER HILL BATTLE

- During the Bunker Hill Battle the British learned to not engage in face to face battles. You could say that it doesn't work for them very well this resulted in many deaths, The colonists used this as a moral boost and made the enemy suffer and became weaker.

1767-THE TOWNSHEND ACT WAS PASSED

- This act was another money maker, the tax was named after Charles Townshend who was the Chancellor of the Exchequer (works with the king.)

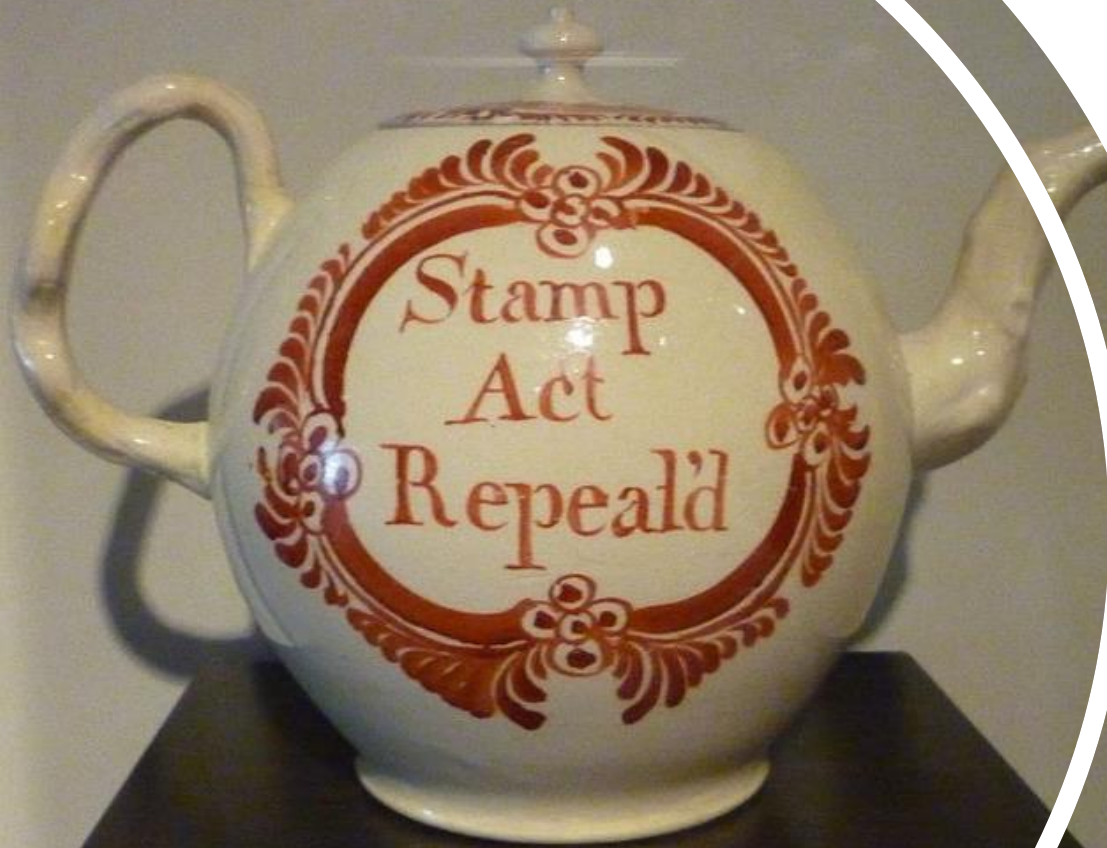


1774- THE FIRST CONTINENTAL CONGRESS WAS FORMED


- This group was made up of 12 british-American state represennitives who disscused the outrageous tax rules and how to solve their problems with the british.
- All states exept georga got together and created the idea of the United States of America.

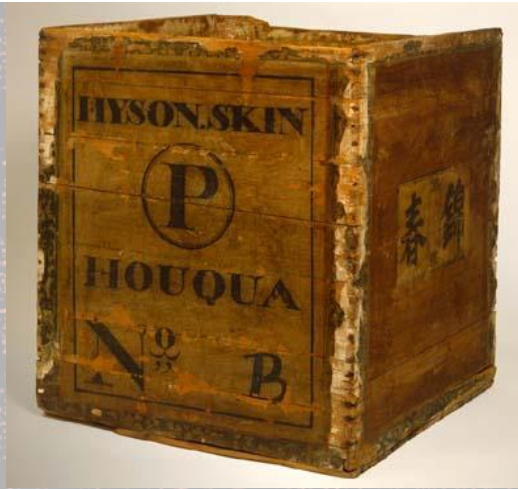
1766- THE STAMP ACT WAS REPEALED
