ITINERARY

DAY 1 HOME CITIES TO TORONTO, ON

Arrive to Toronto. Complimentary airport to airport hotel transfer voucher will be included in your final tour documents. Enjoy a full service hotel as the rest of the day is free to do as you wish. **Meet and join your Tour Director and fellow passengers this evening in the hotel lobby @ 6:30 pm, for a Welcome Get Acquainted Dinner.** **D**

DAY 2 NIAGARA FALLS, ON

Welcome on board our luxury coach this morning. Sit back and enjoy the luxury of our Deluxe Motorcoach. Of course its air conditioned and washroom equipped for your comfort and enjoyment. This morning we are treated to a three-hour locally guided city tour of Toronto After lunch at the Queen's Quay Terminal in Toronto, we proceed along the Queen Elizabeth Highway to Niagara-on-the-Lake. Here we find a thriving community. We stop here for afternoon break before heading to gorgeous Niagara Parkway at "Brock Monument", the "Floral Clock" and "Whirlpool Rapids" for a picture stop. Finally we arrive to Niagara falls, the "Honeymoon Capital of the World" Get ready for a thrilling excursion aboard the "Maid of the Mist." **The evening is free to stroll the parkway on your own for a wonderful view of the lighted falls.** (125km)

DAY 3 BURLINGTON, VT

This morning we cross the Canadian/U.S. border entering into the state of New York. Our leisurely further drive through Syracuse & Lake Placid brings us to Burlington Vermont for the overnight stay. (685 Km)

DAY 4 BANGOR, ME

New England is a moving panorama of country inns, antique shops, lush foliage, small towns and covered bridges. Today we travel through the Green Mountains of Vermont to the beautiful lakes and White Mountain National Forest of New Hampshire to Bangor, Maine for overnight stay. Fall colours will be at their best. Keep your camera ready for some photo opportunities, (451 Km)

DAY 5 SAINT JOHN, NB

This morning we cross the Canadian border and re-enter into Canada. We visit St Andrews-by-the-sea to enjoy the view and visit the quaint little shops. Our further drive along the Bay of Fundy, brings us to the city of Saint John, New Brunswick, the loyalist city. After lunch we will enjoy a locally guided 2 hour city tour of Saint John which includes Reversing Falls and Saint John harbour Late afternoon and evening is free in the heart of downtown for your personal enjoyment. (270 Km)

DAY 6 ANNAPOLIS ROYAL & GRAND PRE. 2 NTS

This morning we depart Saint John on the ferry to Digby, NS, crossing the Bay of Fundy After a leisurely lunch in Digby, we visit Champlain's Habitation at Annapolis Royal and the Grand Pre National Historic Park on the Evangeline Trail We arrive to Halifax/Dartmouth, Nova Scotia for a 2 night stay

DAY 7 CITY TOUR, PEGGY'S COVE & FISHERIES MUSEUM

After a leisurely included breakfast we are treated to a three-hour locally guided tour of the naval city of Halifax. We learn the importance of this seaport city and its many historic sites, including Citadel Hill & Bedford Basin We then make our way to Lunenburg for lunch before a visit to the fascinating Fisheries of the Atlantic Museum We then retrace our steps towards Halifax enroute world's famous Peggy's Cove **We enjoy a dinner and live entertainment this evening at the Dinner Theatre.** (184km) **B, D**

DAY 8 SYDNEY, NS 2 NTS

After a leisurely included breakfast, we travel east, then across the Canso Causeway to Cape Breton This island of hardy Scots, its original settlers, is also rich in its French heritage. We visit the Alexander Graham Bell Museum in Baddeck this afternoon We continue on to Sydney for an early arrival at the hotel for a two-night stay. This evening you may want to try your luck at the nearby full-service casino or enjoy the first-class amenities offered by the hotel (394km) **B**

DAY 9 RITA MACNEIL'S TEAHOUSE & FORTRESS OF LOUISBOURG

Morning is free to rest and relax. We leisurely drive to Rita MacNeil's Teahouse for lunch and browsing After lunch we'll view history as we take a locally guided tour of the Fortress of Louisbourg at 2.00 PM, which exists today as it was 200 years ago Louisbourg is beautifully restored with inhabitants dressed in period costume. We return to our hotel by 5:00PM. Lots of free time for your personal enjoyment.

DAY 10 CABOT TRAIL, CAPE BRETON ISLAND

After a leisurely included breakfast we embark on the magnificent "Cabot Trail", named after the famous explorer who first sighted the island in 1497 This trail could be the scenic highlight of the entire tour – meandering glens, rugged coastlines, white gypsum bluffs and the always pounding surf. We'll be making many picture stops including a picnic lunch enroute to make this a very memorable day. Our overnight stay is in New Glasgow, NS (416km) **B, L**
