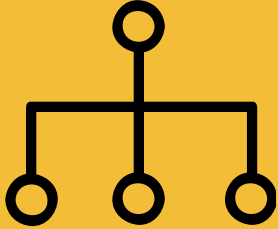


Four I's of OPPRESSION



Ideological

A system of beliefs or ideas



Institutional

Using the laws, the legal system, the education system, public policy, media, political power, etc... to maintain ideology



Interpersonal

The idea that one group is better than another and has the right to dominate/control the other

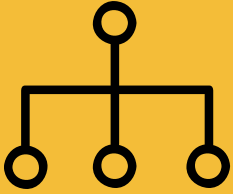


Internalized

The oppressor doesn't have to exert any more pressure, because we now do it to ourselves and each other

The Four I's of OPPRESSION

Ideological



- Toxic Pathological Masculinity involves dominance, control, violence, and sexual aggression. Abusers rely on boys-will-be-boys mindsets.
- "Our society is moving in the direction of permitting, reinforcing, and valuing some of the traits listed in the Psychopathy Checklist...our culture endlessly celebrates the power of the individual above else." -Robert Hare
- Rape cultures "supports and condones sexual abuse by normalizing, trivializing, and eroticizing male violence against women and blaming victims for their own abuse." -Lynn Phillips

Institutional



- This is using legislation, the legal system, the education system, public policy, media, social practices, political power, etc... to maintain male dominance and privilege.
- Warped coverage of sexual violence (See Steubenville rape case)
- Women hold 24.3% of seats in state legislatures. Only 12% of governors and 17% of mayors in the 100 largest American cities are women. (AmericanProgress.org 2014)
- Women earn 80% of what men are paid. Women earn less than men in every profession except stock clerks and order fillers (Bureau of Labor Statistics 2014)
- Only 15.8 to 35% of all sexual assaults are reported to police. (U.S. Bureau of Justice Statistics 2010)

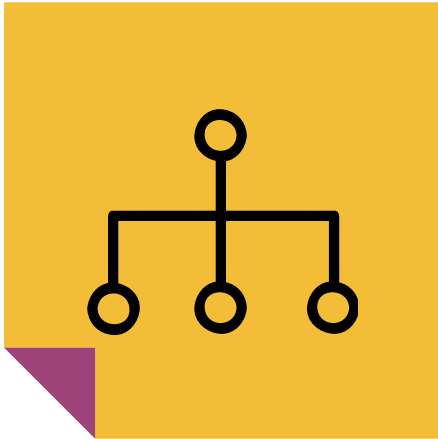
