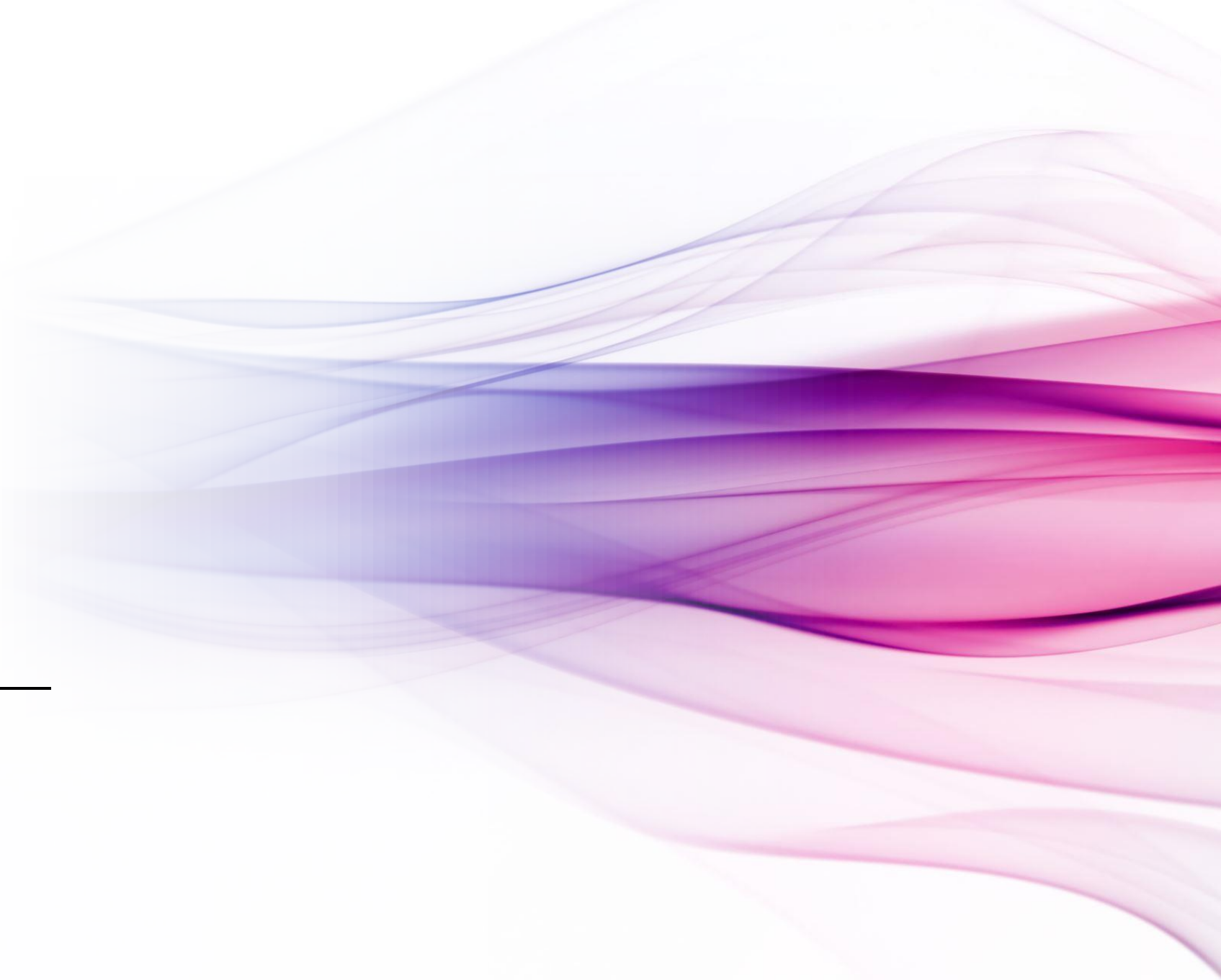

Description of technology (WHAT is it and HOW does it work?)

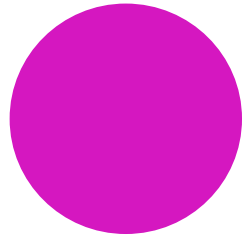
Invention of the technology (WHO created it and WHEN/WHERE was it created?)

How it affects your daily life (WHY is it important?)

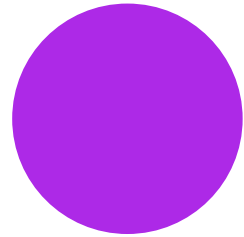
