Dr. Natalie Carter obtained her PhD in Population Medicine/Epidemiology from the University of Guelph in 2015. She is currently a Postdoctoral Fellow and Community Research Lead in the Department of Geography, Environment, and Geomatics at the University of Ottawa. She has engaged in social science research in her PhD and postdoc research. Dr. Carter developed her scholarship in tropical and Arctic regions, investigating how climate change, industrial development, life-supporting environmental and wildlife/livestock systems, culture, and specific government policies (e.g., low-impact shipping corridors, co-management of wildlife sanctuaries, agricultural commodities and land rights) interact with food and social systems to produce health inequities.

In her public presentation, Dr. Carter will discuss noteworthy, recent, and emerging developments in her field of expertise, and how she casts herself as a researcher, a research leader and teacher relative to the field. She will also discuss her application of the One Health approach in her research program, her research progressing in the next five years, and how her area of expertise supports and expands the capacity of the College's and a potential host department's research and teaching strengths.
