Dr. Diana Lewis obtained her PhD in Sociology and Social Anthropology from Dalhousie University in 2018. She is currently an Assistant Professor in the Department of Geography/First Nations Studies Program at Western University. Dr. Lewis is an Indigenous scholar with expertise on environmental health assessment in Indigenous communities. Dr. Lewis conducted innovative research to demonstrate the adverse effects of effluent from a pulp and paper mill on the health of a nearby Indigenous community in Nova Scotia. She is gradually expanding her research to examine Indigenous health in Canada.

In her public presentation, Dr. Lewis will discuss noteworthy, recent, and emerging developments in her field of expertise, and how she casts herself as a researcher, a research leader and teacher relative to the field. She will also discuss her application of the One Health approach in her research program, her research progressing in the next five years, and how her area of expertise supports and expands the capacity of the College's and a potential host department's research and teaching strengths.
