Tri-Cities Child Rights Presentation

- Mr. Stromgren introduced as a worker for the Tri Cities Children's Charter.
- Mr. Lam talks about the charter
 - The idea behind the charter is to bring the voice of children into the community.
 - An invitation was sent to various organizations of children aged 6-12 to contribute thoughts and opinions at an information session.
 - Child Right's organizations came in for a workshop to produce a charter of rights for children.
 - This document will be agreed upon and signed by the city council this May, and will be incorporated into children's rights in BC.
 - Twice a year, child representatives are brought in to help brainstorm ways to introduce this information into the classroom.
 - We'd like students in classrooms to help incorporate this into their education and curriculums.
 - Your support is needed to help make this charter a legitimacy in schools.
